

This course is for participants who already have an avatar and can move and teleport in Second Life. This workshop allows participants to consider options for structuring Second Life experiences: by visiting existing sites in Second Life, by considering whether experiences will be part of a hybrid course or events in Second Life, and whether these will occur in rented or purchased spaces. Using standards provided by Khan's integrated e-learning model, participants will also learn to consider quality for Second Life offerings. Participants will not only have the opportunity to visit and learn about sites that might support his or her instructional interests for Second Life, they will also be provided with a checklist to help develop a plan for his or her own offering in Second Live.
